



- Provided services include, but are not limited to, plumbing, heating/cooling, electrical work, grab bars, and railings.
- Materials for services are to be paid for by the individual requesting the service. All
 contracted services must be approved and authorized by the Department on Aging.
- Please note restrictions may apply.

Home Repair Program

- Small home repair funds, available under our Special Programs, to help homeowners maintain the health and safety conditions of their residence.
- The program offers non-emergency, minor home repair and accessibility modification on a limited basis including grab bars, disability modifications, roof repair, and electrical repairs.
- In addition, for Ashtabula and Geauga County, the Housing Assistance Home Repair Program can fund minor repair projects such as roof repair, electrical and wiring, foundation and drainage, plumbing, etc. for income eligible homeowners.
- All repairs are limited to funding availability.







